Please ensure that the attached Citizen Amendments to the United States Constitution are included on your ballots for the November 2006 Election and that the Citizens of your state are informed with the contents of the attachment. Should a special election need to be held, its cost will be peanuts compared to the Billions of dollars being spent to give the Iraqi Citizens the right to vote.
